

DOLPHIN MOBILE


Many kinds of animal life forms live in the ocean—even some mammals. A dolphin is an air breathing mammal that blows (spouts) to exhale air and it can make several different noises by using an air passage.

Materials:

- Crayons and/or markers
- Duplication of DOLPHIN CUTOUTS two sheets per student
- Hole punch
- Ribbon or string three to six pieces (varying lengths) per student
- Wire coat hanger one per student


Directions:

- 1. Pull a wire coat hanger into any shape. (Do not dismantle the hanger.)
- 2. Cut out dolphins and color them.
- 3. Write the dolphins' names on the back of each dolphin.
- 4. Punch a hole somewhere along the top of each dolphin or punch a hole in the empty circle provided on top of the dolphin.
- 5. Tie the dolphins with string or ribbon and hang them from the hanger.
- Give your finished mobile to your teacher to display in the classroom.
